



## Covid -19 vaccine (jab)



The Covid-19 vaccine (jab) protects people from getting very ill with the virus.



We want people to get the vaccine (jab) to keep them safe and well.



This is the NHS calling to make a Covid-19 vaccine appointment

You may get a letter or telephone call to ask you to come for your appointment.



You will need 2 vaccines.  
You will get 1 vaccine now.



We will tell you when you have  
to come back for your second  
vaccine (jab).



When you come to get your  
vaccine the staff will tell you  
what to do.



We will ask if it is okay for you to get the vaccine (jab).



Remember hands, face, space.



Use hand sanitiser.



Wear a face mask/covering.



Keep 2 meters away from others.



You will get your vaccine (jab) in your arm.



After your vaccine (jab) you will have to sit in the waiting room for 15 minutes.



Staff will tell you when you can go home.



After you get your Covid-19 vaccine (jab) you may have:

A sore arm.

Feel a bit achy.

This is okay.



Do not come to your appointment if you have:



- High temperature



- New Cough



- Loss or change of taste or smell.
